	 The group assignment will be to present an innovative business model for a social enterprise applying the strategic management template of Business Model Canvas. The model will be evaluated according to the following criteria: (1) innovativeness and significance as a whole; (2) value of the idea for sustainable regional development; (3) potential for uptake / implementation; (4) potential for further development in INVEST; (5) communicating the idea with the presentation.

Entry requirements/prerequisites	Students from Slovakia, Bulgaria, Greece, Finland and the Netherlands with a diverse background of studies are expected to take part. BSc (have completed two years of studies), MSc or PhD student. Minimum requirements for English language level is B2. Each partner university will select 5 students. Application should be sent to the respective coordinator by 10 April 2022. The application should be in the form of a motivation letter or video, including motivation for taking the course and how the student plans to utilize the information which he/she will gain from the course.
